How To Be A Grill Master

Men need to barbecue; it's something primal within us. I pride myself on being "Master of the Grill" but it took me a few years to perfect my skills. Here's what I know: You have to start early! Light the coals and bring the grill up to temperature. The trick with low and slow barbecuing is to keep the temperature even. So start with a third of a bag of charcoal and slowly add coals until you have the right temperature. This is an exercise in patience (something I am not known for) but it's well worth it to get the best chicken you have ever had.



Dr D's Grilled Thyme Chicken (serves 2 - 4)

Ingredients 1 whole chicken For The Thyme Butter 4 oz unsalted butter, softened 2 garlic cloves, crushed 2 sprigs of thyme, leaves picked and finely chopped Zest of a lemon Juice of half a lemon* For The Rub

tbsp sea salt flakes
tsp soft light brown sugar
tsp black peppercorns
tsp mustard powder
tsp garlic granules
Sprigs of thyme, remove and finely chopped leaves.

Directions:

- 1. Remove the legs from the chicken by cutting down either side of the main body, popping through the thigh joint and cutting round to release the leg and thigh in one piece. Next, use a sharp pair of kitchen scissors to remove the spine by turning the chicken upside down and cutting through the ribs on either side of the spine, leaving the breasts and wings attached to the breast bone. (Not sure how to do this? There are a lot of YouTube videos that will show you step by step how to butterfly a whole chicken)
- 2. Ease your hand under the skin on the breasts, being careful not to pierce the skin, so that you have a large pocket.
- 3. Mix together the soft butter, garlic, thyme, lemon zest and juice with a little seasoning. Push the butter evenly underneath the skin of the breast.
- 4. Mix together all of the rub ingredients and sprinkle over the chicken breasts and legs. Cover and chill for 2-4 hours.

- 5. Remove from the fridge 1 hour before cooking. Heat the barbecue to medium (around 450 F), with either the coals banked up on one side (or if using gas one side of the gas burners turned off).
- 6. Place the chicken legs and the chicken with the underside of the breast bone facing down (the thickest part of the chicken) over the edge of the coals and grill for 25-30 minutes with the hood of the grill down. Turn regularly until lightly caramelized and cooked through. If using a gas grill, place the chicken over the side of the grill with the burners off. An instant thermometer will help tremendously the desired temp is 165 F. I prefer the Cuisinart Bluetooth Meat Thermometer with 2 probes.
- 7. With 2-3 minutes left, put the chicken breast and legs, skin-side down directly over the coals/burners, and cook until the skin is crisp.
- 8. Squeeze over the juice of the remaining $\frac{1}{2}$ lemon, carve and serve

Don't Have a Grill?

You can cook this in the oven too. Heat your oven to 400 degrees. Cook the legs on a baking tray for 10 minutes, then put the rest into roast alongside for 50 minutes. Allow to rest, covered with foil, for 15 minutes.

2 oz Vodka ½ fresh lime Lime wedge for garnish Copper mug

4 oz Fever Tree Ginger Beer

Directions:

Fill your copper mug with ice, add vodka and the juice of half a lime. Top off with ginger beer and garnish with a wedge of lime. Dr's Note: If

you don't have a copper mug you can use an old fashioned glass but the copper mug really adds to the experience.


