# Dr D's Fast Farfalle Dinner

(serves 4)

Being a doctor means that you are never really "off duty" so sometimes dinner can get interrupted. This quick and easy recipe is perfect when time is short and leftovers heat up nicely allowing for an even quicker lunch the following day! But don't think of this recipe as "basic" I've been known to serve it at dinner parties too - just serve with my delicious Caesar salad when company comes.

## Ingredients:

- Sea salt
- 10 slices pancetta or thick bacon
- 1 pound dried farfalle pasta
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 tablespoon butter
- Freshly ground black pepper
- 2 cups frozen peas
- 2 tablespoons heavy cream
- 2 tablespoons fresh sage leaves
- Juice of 1/2 lemon
- 6 ounces grated Parmesan cheese

## Directions:

Bring a large pot of lightly salted to boil. While water comes to the boil julienne the pancetta. Add pasta to boiling water

In a large skillet over medium heat, add 2 tablespoons olive oil and the butter. Add pancetta and fry until crisp. Add frozen peas and stir for a minute or two. Add heavy cream and sage.

Drain the pasta and stir into the sauce. Add lemon juice, and salt and pepper to taste. Bring to a simmer and remove from heat. The sauce will be thick but if you prefer a little milk may be added to the sauce to thin it out.

Divide into 4 dishes and top with parmesan.

# My Delicious Caesar Salad

(serves 4)

Caesar dressing is easy to make and so much more delicious when homemade. One of my "top ten" meals of all time featured a rotund old fashioned waiter making Caesar dressing tableside in a huge wooden bowl New Years Eve in Rochester in 1991.

## Ingredients:

- 1 clove of garlic, finely chopped
- 2 egg yolks
- 2 tbsp white wine vinegar
- 2 tsp Dijon mustard
- 8 drained anchovy fillets (see directions)\*
- 3 tsp Worcestershire sauce
- 1 cup olive oil
- 3 baby cos lettuce, leaves separated

**Directions:** Process garlic, 1 tsp of sea salt, yolks, vinegar, mustard, 4 of the anchovies\* and Worcestershire sauce using a food processor until combined. With the motor running, add olive oil in a slow steady stream until dressing is thick, then season to taste with a pinch of sugar, sea salt and freshly ground black pepper

Place lettuce leaves, parmesan, and enough dressing to coat in a large bowl add croutons and toss well to combine. Divide into serving bowls and top with reserved anchovies. Serve immediately.



# Summer Rose

This fresh, floral and light cocktail gets its blush from fresh blueberries. It's easy to make and Mom will love it! (serves 1)

## Ingredients:

- 2 oz. dry gin
- 1 oz. fresh lemon juice
- 1 oz. lavender simple syrup\*
- handful of fresh blueberries

**Directions:** In a shaker, muddle the blueberries then top with ice. Add the gin, lemon and syrup. Shake and strain into a chilled coupe.

**\*For the lavender syrup:** Bruise ¼ cup of dried lavender in a plastic bag with a rolling pin. Add 1 cup of granulated sugar to 1 cup of water and bring to a boil, stirring until the sugar is dissolved. Add the lavender leaves and simmer for 5 minutes. Cool slightly. Buzz through a blender (hold a kitchen towel over the lid so it doesn't explode). Cool overnight and strain into a bottle. Keeps for 2 weeks refrigerated.

## What To Expect During And After My Procedure

We begin by using a marking pen to determine exactly where the sutures should be placed in your skin to give a very natural result. Next, you will be injected with a local anesthetic to numb the area and the (fully resorbable) sutures will be inserted (the number of sutures varies from patient to patient). 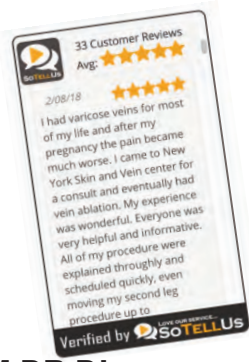
