

Can you believe that it's already Fall? The days are getting shorter and the weather is as unpredictable as ever in Upstate New York. I'm closing up my camp until Spring, but I'm not sad because the cooler weather means that I can wear my cashmere sweaters again and sup my favorite soups. On busy evenings you'll love this delicious lemony chicken soup. It's an easy recipe, the trick is to pour the broth over the eggs slowly while whisking continuously (to avoid chicken flavored scrambled eggs).

Dr D's Too Busy To Cook Lemony Chicken Soup (Serves 4)

Ingredients: 4 cups chicken broth ¼ cup orzo 1 large egg 2 egg yolks Grated zest of a lemon Juice of 1 lemon Kosher salt and black pepper to taste Breast of chicken, shredded*

Directions: Add chicken broth to a medium saucepan and bring to the boil. Add orzo and cook for about 7 minutes (you want it al dente).

Whisk together egg, egg yolks, lemon zest, and lemon juice in a bowl until foamy and pale yellow.

When orzo is ready, pour half a cup of hot stock into the egg mixture in a slow steady stream whisking continually.

Lower the heat to medium-low and SLOWLY pour the egg/soup mix back into the saucepan whisking constantly.

Simmer gently, stirring frequently, until thin enough to coat the back of a wooden spoon, 8 to 10 minutes. Season with salt and pepper.

Add shredded chicken breast, garnish with lemon zest and black pepper and serve immediately.

*Dr's Note: Use store bought rotisserie chicken to save time.

Lemon & Rosemary Bourbon Sour (Serves 1)

Ingredients:

 ½ oz Bourbon (any brand)
 oz fresh squeezed lemon juice
 3/4 oz Rosemary Simple Syrup
 Rosemary sprigs to garnish (and for syrup, see right) **Directions:** In a cocktail shaker, combine bourbon, lemon juice, Rosemary Simple Syrup and ice; shake well. Pour cocktail with ice into double rocks glass and garnish with rosemary sprig, if desired.

To Make Rosemary Simple Syrup:Gently hit 3 sprigs of rosemary with back of knife to release aroma. Transfer to a small saucepan, stir in $\frac{1}{2}$ cup sugar and $\frac{1}{2}$ cup water and heat until sugar is dissolved. Allow to cool. Refrigerate and can use for up to 5 days.

This Halloween Don't Let Your Neck Be The **SCARIEST** Thing People See!


collagen and elastin production which tightens the skin leaving it smooth and firm. Thermitight works well for moderate to severe loose sagging necks and can be combined with neck liposuction to remove excess fat too. It only takes 30 minutes and is performed under local anesthesia in the office. In less than a week, your neck will look like it used to when you were younger.

KYBELLA is the only FDA approved treat-



ment that dissolves fat cells under the chin to improve your profile. When injected into the fat beneath the chin, kybella® kills your fat cells, resulting in a noticeable reduction in fullness under the chin. Once destroyed, these cells can no longer store or accumulate fat and don't grow back. Kybella is a painless injection into the fat that only takes 5 minutes. After the treatment the area will be slightly more swollen for a few days and then the kybella starts to work. It usually takes 2 to 3 sessions to get to your final goal of smoothing your double chin.

NEFERTITI LIFT (named for the ancient Egyptian



queen who was famous for her long and graceful neckline) is a non-invasive procedure that can restore a more youthful contour to your jawline and upper neck at the same time. Treatment requires a wrinkle relaxer like Botox which is injected into the platysma muscles (the muscles on either side of the neck that create prominent bands that pull down the corners of the jaw line each time they contract. When the wrinkle relaxer begins working, the muscles under the jaw and neck relax; this allows the neck to smooth out and the upward-pulling facial muscles to lift up the cheeks. This result is a reduction in the skin drooping of the jawline and a smoother appearance to the upper neck, giving you a more youthful, contoured jawline. The NEFERTITI lift can be combined with wrinkle fillers injected above the jaw bone to give an even more defined jawline.

EXILIS ULTRA 360™ is a dual-wavelength



treatment that uses both radiofrequency and ultrasound energy. exilis combines fat melting and skin tightening in a simple non-invasive procedure. This works well anywhere on the face and especially the neck. It is completely pain free and uses no needles or anesthesia. Most women say it feels like a hot stone massage.

TECHNECK is a condition that is affecting



even young women and is the result of looking down at a laptop or phone for hours each day. It creates horizontal indentations in the skin that make your neck look much older than you are. Fortunately "techneck"

can be reversed but it requires a three step combination treatment in order to smooth out the lines and fill in the indentations.

Step 1: Exilis Ultra is used to stimulate collagen and create long term smoothing.

Step 2: The NEFERTITI lift is performed to smooth out the lines short term, and

Step 3: A wrinkle filler like Restylane is also used to fill in the indentations and stimulate collagen.

The treatment program takes approximately one month to complete and will improve "techneck" lines by at least 50 to 80%.

REDNECK is not the name of a southern hick



but what happens with sun exposure causing damage to the skin overtime. The medical name is **Poikiloderma of Civatte** and looks like reddish-brown patches with thinning of the skin that symmetrically involve sun-exposed areas of the sides of the neck. It usually spares the shaded area under the chin. We have the perfect treatment for Poikiloderma: Laser Skin Rejuvenation with the Excel V laser that seals shut the blood vessels causing the red color. This evens out the color of your neck so that it looks like normal skin again. It usually takes 2 or 3 treatment sessions and feels like a mild rubber band snap.


